

# Utah Firearm Safe Rebate

In response to 2021 House Bill 336 – Suicide Prevention Amendments, the Utah Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health, in conjunction with the Utah Suicide Prevention Coalition, is offering a limited, one-time rebate for the purchase of one firearm safe starting November 1, 2021. The rebate is valid for up to \$200 of the pre-tax sales amount.

This amendment supports the Utah Suicide Prevention Coalition's "IS YOUR SAFETY ON?" campaign and its efforts in firearm suicide prevention. Eighty-six percent of firearms deaths in Utah are suicides. Utah ranks in the top 10 in the nation in suicide deaths. Putting time and distance between a person at risk of suicide and a firearm may save a life. Together we can protect our family and friends.

## *Program Requirements*

---

1. Utah resident.
2. Age 18 or older.
3. Valid email.
4. Completion of firearm suicide prevention video (accessible on the application).
5. Purchase of a qualified safe on or after November 1, 2021.

---

## *Rebate Process*

---

- A. Visit our [application](#) to submit proof of purchase (PDF copy of your receipt).
- B. Once submitted, participants will receive a confirmation email from [pradmin@kissflow.com](mailto:pradmin@kissflow.com).
- C. Once proof of purchase is received and verified by a member of the Rebate team, participants will be mailed a rebate check and receive an email confirmation the payment has been issued.
- D. Checks will be delivered via USPS mail.

This is not an automatic system. This process is reviewed and verified manually by a small team at Utah Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health. The turnaround time is approximately three weeks. We have received feedback that our emails may be delivered to junk/spam folders. ## *Important Limitations*

---

1. Rebates will be issued until the funding is exhausted, and will be honored first-come first-serve, with completed and correct submissions.
2. Limit one per Utah resident.
3. Purchases prior to November 1, 2021 will not be accepted or reimbursed.

### *Safe Qualifications*

---

For this program, a firearm safe is defined as:

- A. A gun safe, gun case, lock box, or other device;
- B. Is designed to fully contain one or more firearm;
- C. Has the ability to be securely locked and unlocked by means of a key, combination, or other similar means; and
- D. Excludes rooms, glass and/or wooden gun cabinets, tool boxes, softshell field cases, and vehicle safes.

### *Frequently Asked Questions*

---

- “Is this a scam?”
  - This is a legitimate program, please see [Utah Statute 62A-15-103 \(3\) \(c\)](#).
- “Can my partner and I both apply?”
  - This program is limited to one per resident, not per household. We do not accept the same receipt for the same household if the pre-tax price is less than \$400.00.
- “How is the rebate amount determined?”
  - The rebate amount is \$200 of the pre-tax price, or the cost of the safe, if below \$200. For example, if you purchase a \$100 safe, the eligible rebate is \$100. If you purchase a \$500 safe, \$200 is eligible.
- “Do I have to buy from a certain store?”
  - An eligible safe must be purchased from a participating firearms dealer or a person engaged in the business of selling firearm safes in Utah. All major retailers are accepted. Purchases from Craig’s List, KSL, Facebook Marketplace, yard sales, person-to-person sales, etc. will not be accepted.
- “I participated in the rebate program two years ago. Can I still apply?”
  - Yes, if you participated in the 2019 Firearm Safe Rebate Program, you are still eligible to participate in the 2021 program. However, you can not submit a previously used receipt. The safe must be purchased on or after November 1, 2021.
